Within the conference the contest of students, undergraduates, graduate students and young scientists (up to age 35 years) "Physical Activity in addressing the improvement of the quality and duration of life on Earth and in space" will be held in the following areas:

- 1. Management technologies of the functional state, the rate of aging, efficient and successful business.
- 2. Hypokinesia, light pollution, desynchronosis and aging: the state of problems and solutions
- 3. The problem of the influence of anthropogenic load of environment on health, longevity and quality of life
 - 4. Effect of different shapes and varieties of culture on the longevity and quality of life
 - 5. Actual problems of high performance sport.

6. The sports complex "Ready for Labor and Defense" (TRP): yesterday, today and tomorrow.

Requirements for the articles:

The conference materials will be published in the scientific materials compilation. The volume of articles should be at least four (4) - not more than ten (10) pages (for pupils and students - 3 pages) through a 1.0 interval, including the bibliography. The font size in the tables can be reduced to 12. The text can not contain hyphenation. A4 page in the editor Word, font Times New Roman, font size - 14. All fields - 2.5 cm., Width adjustment page. The article can be in the form of an analytical review (based on scientific publications over the past 5 years), or as a description of the results of your own experimental research (basic or applied).

In the upper left corner of the article you must specify the UDC (http://teacode.com/online/udc/). Title of the article is written in capital letters in **bold**, the next line - the author's name (s) and initials, the third line - the full name of the institution, city and country are written in *italics*, centered.

The structure of the article should necessarily include: the relevance and purpose of the study, the organization of the experiment and research methods, results and discussion, conclusions.

Bibliography at the end of the article is called LITERATURE and is made in alphabetical order according to the requirements of GOST (of no more than 15 sources). The references in the text are given in numbers corresponding to the number of the author in the references in square brackets. For example: [1].

Abstract (no more than 2,000 characters) and key words (up to 5) in *Russian* must be attached to each article in a separate file, as well as the title of the article, names of authors, institution, abstract and keywords in *English*. For works presented in English, you must attach the article title, authors' names, institution, abstract and key words in *Russian*.

The author is responsible for the content of the article and copyright compliance. The organizing committee reserves the right to select articles. Articles, designed not according to the rules, as well as Article abstracts, are not accepted, reviewed and returned. Each author can be co-author of only two articles presented in the Conference Collection of articles. Texts of articles are published in author's edition. The organizing committee reserves the right to reduce the volume of the article.

Collection of articles is located in the Science Library (eLibrary.ru) and will be included in the Russian Science Citation Index (RISC), a collection of essays assigned ISBN, bibliographic characters (UDC and BBK)
